



## Position Description

**Job Title:** Interim Contemporary Worship Director

**Timeframe:** December 26, 2018 – June 1, 2019

**Reports to:** Pastor of Music and Administration

**Position Status:** Part-time, 15-20 hours per week

**Purpose:** We are seeking a part-time Contemporary Worship Director to oversee the Contemporary Worship Service and the vision as set forth by the Pastor of Music and Administration, Senior Pastor, and Elder Board. In this role, the Contemporary Worship Director will have an exalted and growing appreciation of the glory of God and of the love of Jesus Christ, a current knowledge of music and worship trends and elements, and a passion to help the church family engage Spiritually in worship. The Interim Contemporary Worship Director is encouraged to apply for the full-time position.

### Qualifications

- One who measures up to the character qualifications found in 1 Timothy 3:8-13 and lives out a life centered on Jesus Christ
- One with a degree in music or working towards a degree in music or equivalent experience
- One who embraces the church's vision statement, vision of worship, and confessional statement
- One who has the ability to work with chord charts, lead sheets, and other forms of sheet music
- One who has a background in sound, lighting, and slide projection
- One who has a background with a variety of instruments including but not limited to drums, guitar, and bass and the ability to instruct or train as needed
- One with a passion to reach out to all the people in the church body, in order to draw each one lovingly into worship of the Living God
- One who is eager to work in a spirit of cooperation with the Music Ministries team and has a teachable heart
- One with the ability to develop and lead teams and delegate effectively
- One whose interpersonal skills reflect the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ

### Responsibilities

- To provide oversight for all musical elements in the contemporary worship service
- To lead contemporary worship with a guitar or keyboard and to have the vocabulary to work with all contemporary instrumentalists
- To provide oversight for all those involved in the contemporary band (musicians and AVL personnel).

- To schedule all propresenter operators and band members based upon the needs of each worship service
  - To implement the Vision of Worship as set forth by the Pastor of Music and Administration, Senior Pastor, and Elder Board
  - To practice worship songs in advance with the band insuring the most compelling presentation, evoking maximum congregational participation
  - To meet weekly with the Pastor of Music and Administration to plan and evaluate worship services, arrange songs as needed, and discuss other creative elements
  - To provide all necessary information for all related worship bulletins
  - To collaborate with the Pastor of Music and Administration on liturgical and church family life calendars
  - To maintain administrative tasks such as typing worship slides in propresenter, printing weekly worship songs and compiling folders for the band
  - To lead in other special services and events as needed
  - To maintain inventory of contemporary equipment such as instruments, microphones, and supplies. The Interim Contemporary Worship Director will make recommendations of ministry needs to the Pastor of Music and Administration.
