Call to Worship Psalm 118:19-21; 24

Open to me the gates of righteousness, that I may enter through them and give thanks to the Lord. This is the gate of the Lord; the righteous shall enter through it. I thank you that you have answered me and have become my salvation. This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

Scripture Philippians 3:7-11

But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith—that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, that by any means possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead.

Prayer Use Philippians 3:7-11 to guide your prayer. Let everyone share and pray as they are led. This Sunday, follow the ACTS model:

Adoration – Praise God for who He is.

Confession – Confess our sins to God and asking for forgiveness.

Thanksgiving – Give thanks to God for things He has done.

Supplication – Lift up things only God can do according to His will.

Pray for others and for ourselves.
